Minimum KRI Level 1 certification requirements for i-SKY courses

1 Full attendance of course within 24 months and completion of all other certification requirements prior to attendance of your final weekend or within 6 months thereafter (and in any case within 2 years of commencement).

4 Completion of two 40-day kriya (meditation/exercise set or both - 11min minimum for each).

5 Pass mark in the final weekend sit down exam or submission of a satisfactory Take Home exam.

6 Completion of coursework and take-home exam to a satisfactory standard before the final weekend (or within 6 months thereafter).

7 Attendance of a one-day White Tantra Yoga Course (6d below is required if WTY is not offered in the region).

8 KRI require minimum attendance of 20 Kundalini Yoga classes outside the course.

9 Full payment of all fees due.

10 Confidential evaluation of the performance of your Teacher Trainers
